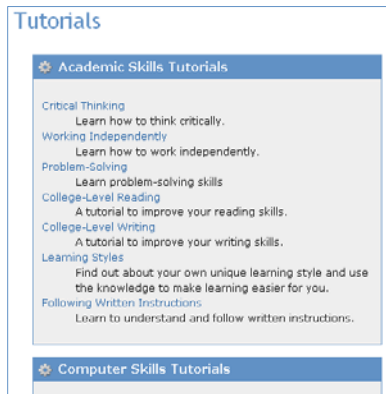
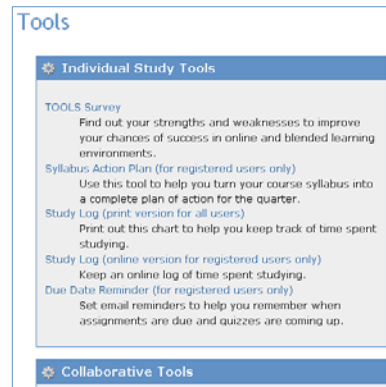


MyStudySpace is a place on the web where students who need to can find tutorials, cognitive tools, collaboration tools, and campus resources to improve their study skills.

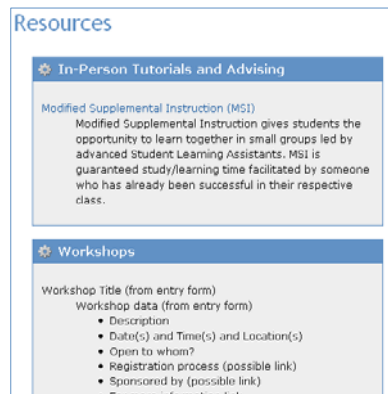

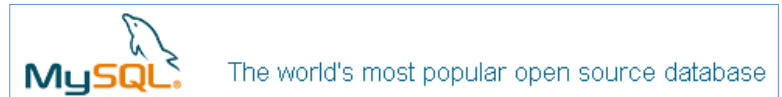

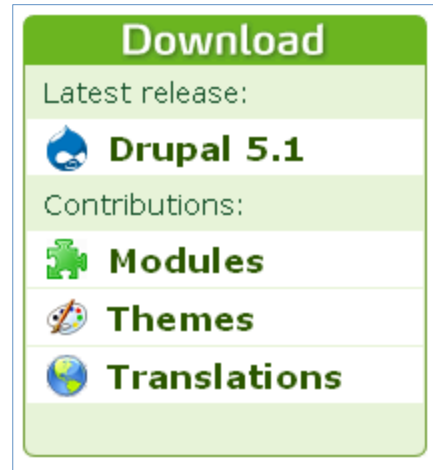
